Exploring repeated pattern

During this unit the children learnt to develop their techniques, including their control and their use of materials, with creativity, experimentation and an increasing awareness of different kinds of art, craft and design. The unit question was: How can we work with pattern in a mindful way to create artwork which can be applied to many outcomes?

The examples here show the progression throughout KS2.

First level

Pupil has thought about the pattern design, but hasn't thought as much about how the repeated pattern will look as a final product. They have selected interesting shapes, but needs to focus on colour and material selection.



Second level

Pupil has used contrasting colours that complement each other well. They have thought more carefully about the placement of the materials to create the final repeated pattern.

	
Third level	Pupil has created a design which includes contrasting colours and shapes, with careful use of blank space. They have chosen a variety of patterned material, and bold and lighter colours. The use of both vertical and horizontal lines has created balance for the final design.
