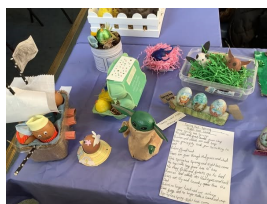
On this day we would also like to invite children to come to school in dress down clothes in the theme of red, white and blue to raise money for the Royal British Legion Industries (RBLI),
