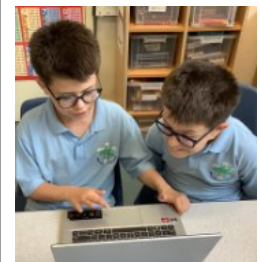
Mrs Kaye will be leaving Bishop Wilton but will be continuing with the Federation at Beswick.
