Weekly Phonics:

- Your child is currently accessing **Phase 6**.
- Use www.phonicsplay.co.uk to access activities from Phase 4 to Phase 6 (Username: march20 Password: home).
- This week revise and practise adding the suffix 'ed'.
- Use the past tense penguin game on phonics play.
- Use www.spellingshed.com to practise spellings. Spelling lists will be changed weekly.

Writing:

- Plan and write a character description of the giant from the story you read last week – What does he look like? What is his character like? Would you like to be his friend?
- Now listen to the story of Jack and the Magic Baked Beanstalk (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=1T8-yNxseEQ>) Is this giant different?
- Draw and label a picture of a giant from your own imagination. Make him a kind giant!
- Now write a character description of your own giant.

- Use My Rising Stars website, log in to read your allocated books and attempt the activities/quizzes at the end. (These will be changed weekly)
- A selection of books has been provided. Read your child's own books to them. Can they ask you a question about each page read?
