Weekly Phonics:

- Your child is currently accessing **Phase 4**.
- Use www.phonicsplay.co.uk to access activities from Phase 1 to Phase 4. (Username: march20 Password: home)
- Practise reading CCVC words (Try dragon's den on phonics play and choose the appropriate section). Try writing some words yourself and ask your child to draw on sound buttons and then attempt to write the words themselves. Hide some words in the garden this week and have a treasure hunt to find them.
- Make up some silly sentences using the words.
- Continue to use the flash cards to practise all the graphemes and tricky words we know.

Writing:

- Draw a picture of the giant from Jack and the Beanstalk. Label your picture.
- Write some sentences to describe the giant.
- Now listen to the story of Jack and the Magic Baked Beanstalk (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=1T8-yNxseEQ>)
- Talk about how this giant is different.

Reading:

- Use My Rising Stars website, log in to read your allocated books and attempt the activities/quizzes at the end. (These will be changed weekly)
- A selection of books has been provided. Read daily and talk about the book. Encourage your child to ask questions.

Number Skills:

- Cut up some paper and write the numbers from 1-20. Lay them out in order but with a single mistake. Can your child find the mistake?
- Practise number formation.

- Use objects to subtract a single digit number.

P.E.

- You could use Joe Wicks workout sessions on his you tube channel.

Other:

This term we are looking at plants and growing.

- Can you plant some seeds if you have any? How will you need to look after them?
- If you can get cress seeds, use an egg shell and make a face on it. Plant cress for the hair and have fun giving your egg head a haircut when it grows.
- Can you use junk modelling materials to make a plant or flower?
- Record what the weather is like each day. You could make some weather symbols and create a weather chart.
