Weekly Phonics:

Writing: Jack and the Beanstalk

- Following on from the previous week, this week you are going to design and make your own house for you alternative character e.g. for the giant this was his castle
- Start by drawing what you would like your alternative character's house to look like- label it thinking about what materials you can use
- Using your design make your alternative character's house using different materials e.g. cardboards, plastic bottles, bottle lids, wrappers.
- After you have finished your house think about some adjectives you could use to describe the different parts of your house e.g. the windows, door, roof.
- Then write a small paragraph describing your alternative character's house e.g. On top of the princess castle there is a chimney which is long and wonky.

Reading:

- Use My Rising Stars website, log in to read your allocated books and attempt the activities/quizzes at the end. (These will be changed weekly)
- Have a look in your book collection. Do you have any stories that are similar to Jack and the Beanstalk? This could be traditional tales, stories about giants, stories with magical characters or objects etc...

Geography

- This week we are looking at extreme weather.
- Use construction sets e.g. to build several houses until you have got a village.
- Place the houses in a plastic box and put sponges between the houses and slowly pour water onto the sponges
- Ask what do you think might happen?
- Then the sponge is full of water it will start to overflow and then flood around the houses. Explain to the children that this shows why there was so much flooding earlier in the year. The ground usually soaks up the rain, when it rains too much the ground can't soak up any more rain and then rain sits on top of the ground as floods.
- Show video – www.youtube.co.uk Why do floods happen? Scishow kids (just show the first two minutes).
- Discuss why is flooding so dangerous

Science

- This week we are looking at life cycles- discuss that both plants and animals have life cycles
- Watch <https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/clips/z3wsbk7> life cycle of a plant
- Can you draw the life cycle of a sunflower?
- Act out the life cycle of a sunflower starting as a curled up seed, watering (spray bottle of water), growing (torch for the sun) flowering, producing seeds, then dies and new seeds grow.

R.E

- Discuss and recap the creation stories- Christianity and Islamic
- Draw 2 pictures - one of your favourite part of the Christian creation story and one of the Islamic creation story.
- You can use paints, chalk, or even make a collage.

D&T/Art

- Continue to explore spirals by using natural materials to create spirals see examples below:
