Weekly Phonics:

- Your child is currently accessing **Phase 4**.
- Use www.phonicsplay.co.uk to access activities from Phase 1 to Phase 4. (Username: march20 Password: home)
- Continue to practise reading CCVC and CVCC words (use the phonics play games as appropriate).
- This week focus on the phase 4 tricky words and practise reading them using the phonics play game (See list in home support).
- Then attempt to write the words in a sentence.
- Continue to use the flash cards to practise all the sounds we know.

Writing: The Tadpole's Promise

- This half term we are starting our new book the Tadpole's Promise
- Watch the Tadpole's Promise being read on YouTube (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=eKMI-a3-uNY>). Make some props, dress up and act out the story with your family.
- Draw a story map and re-tell the story to your favourite teddy and then to an adult using some of the language in the story.
- Write a sentence to say which part of the story you liked best.

Reading:

- Use My Rising Stars website, log in to read your allocated books and attempt the activities/quizzes at the end. (These will be changed weekly)
- If your child is enjoying using the teddy then hide it around the house and put on a new sign. 'I'm excited. Please read me an adventure story'. Encourage your child to share a favourite adventure story book with the teddy.

Maths Skills:

- Revisit time this week. Use your clock to practise telling the o'clock times.
- Solve some simple problems by asking your child questions – one hour before and one hour after. For example – It is three o'clock now and Peppa Pig starts in one hour. What time will it start?
- Revisit and practise counting back from 20 starting from any number. www.youtube.com Counting down from 20 song.
- Begin to count beyond 20 with your child.

Other:

Physical

Creative

- Use a bucket of water and a paintbrush to create flower pictures on any hard surfaces in your garden.
- Experiment with different brushes or sponges.
- Draw some bees landing on your flowers.
- Write your name in water beside your picture.
